

## DIRECTIONS:

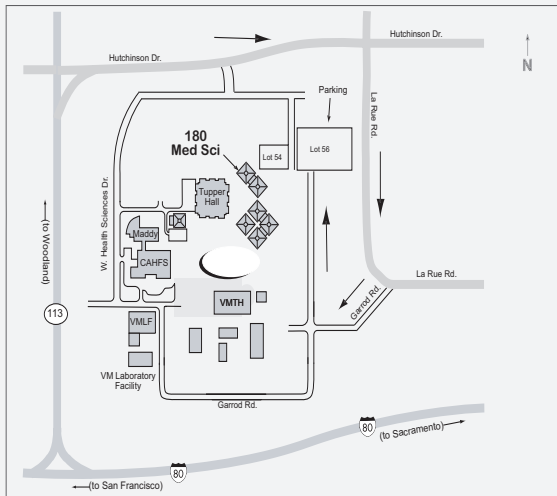
### From Sacramento:

Travel west on I-80 to Davis. Take Hwy 113 north (toward Woodland). Exit on Hutchison Drive (1st exit) and bear right toward the UCD campus. Turn right on La Rue Road and take first right on Garrod Road. You will come to a T intersection. Turn right and follow the small road to Parking Lot 56. Parking is free on Saturdays and Sundays.

### From the Bay Area:
